Schedule of the Program





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On 28th July 2019, Sri ABR Government Degree College in Repalle organized an orientation program for the incoming batch of students. The program aimed to acquaint the students with the college's policies, procedures, and facilities, as well as to provide guidance on their academic and personal growth.

The program began with the presidential remarks by Dr. G Mallikarjun, the Principal of the college, who welcomed the students and highlighted the college's values, vision, and mission. The seventh session was conducted by Smt. A V Kavitha, who discussed the college's policies on anti-ragging and gender sensitization. She stressed the importance of maintaining a safe and respectful campus environment and encouraged the students to report any incidents of ragging or discrimination. Smt. Kavitha also discussed the various initiatives that the college had taken to promote gender sensitization, such as organizing awareness campaigns, setting up grievance redressal cells, and providing counselling services.
